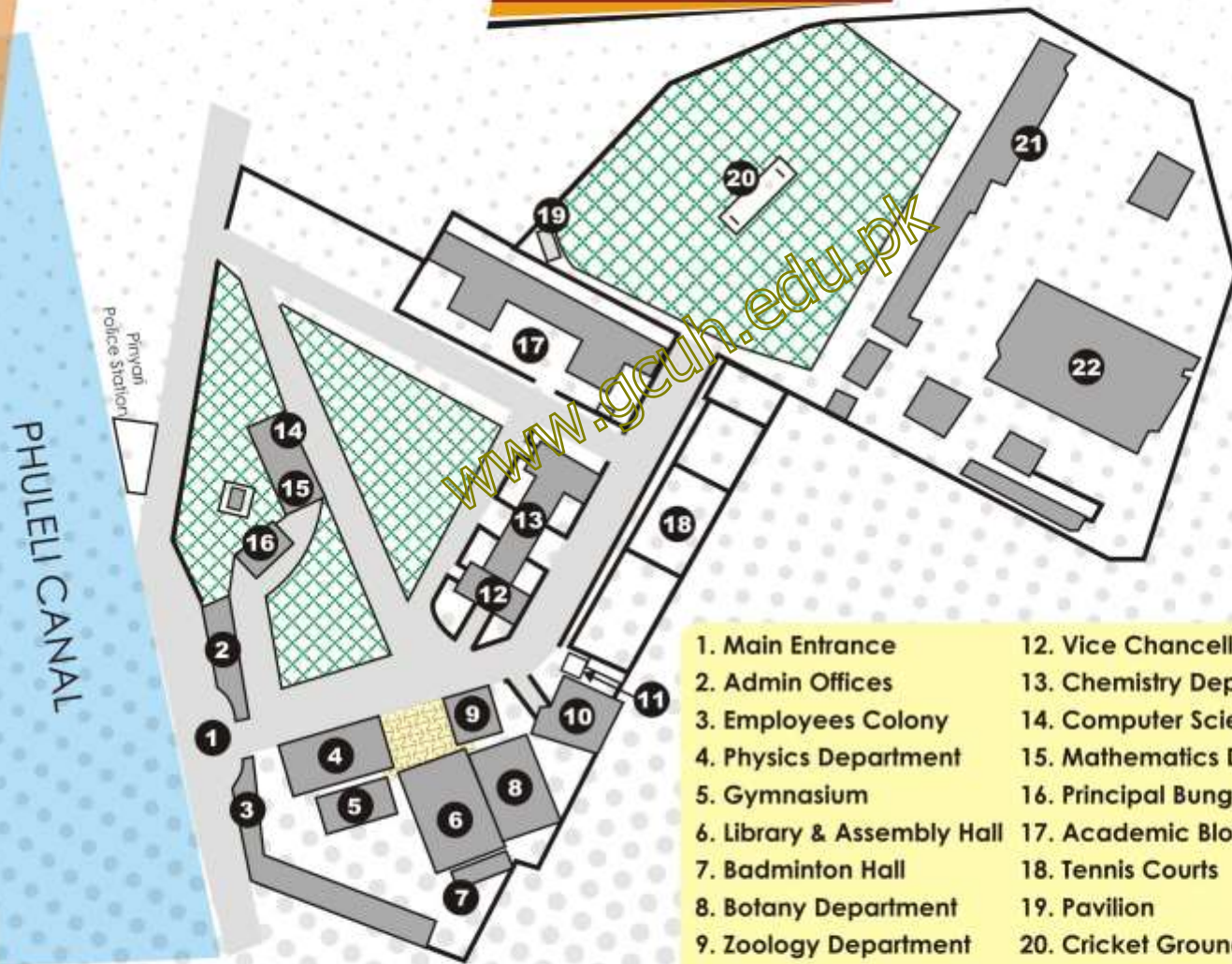

INAUGURATION OF NATIONAL ARTS COLLEGE HYDERABAD IN 1917

Located beside the left bank of Phuleli canal, Government College University Hyderabad is one of the oldest and prime educational institutions of Pakistan. Its enchanting red-brick building, lush green botanical gardens and orchids around it have mesmerizing effect on its viewer. Its genesis dates back to 1st October, 1917 with the title of "Sind National Arts College Hyderabad" being contemplated by International Theosophical Society. The key role in running the International Theosophical Society was played by its second president, Dr. Annie Besant, a well known educationist, orator, political and social figure of undivided Indian sub-continent. She wrote more than 300 books and pamphlets. Due to some political conflict with the Indian National Congress, Dr. Besant was detained during the summer of 1917 for few months. During her detention, Dr. Ernest Egerton Wood, the secretary to National Educational Trust,

continued the activities of "National Educational Movement". He appealed through the newspapers for the establishment of new educational institutes in India. Since there was no college in Hyderabad Sind, the students who wanted to continue for higher education, had to go far off cities like Bombay. The first response of huge contribution appeared from a youth of Sind with a donation of Rs.20,000/= on a condition to establish a college in Hyderabad Sind. Among the other elite of the city of Hyderabad, there was another prominent figure, Diwan Dayaram Gidumal, a judge as a profession. He was the main pillar in the establishment of a college in Hyderabad Sind. Dr. Wood, after a tedious journey from Madras proceeded to Hyderabad Sind on 24th August, 1917. Within a week, the people of Hyderabad Sind donated huge amount of worth around £.5000/=. The donation amount was quite enough to launch the institute. So Dr. Wood within five weeks purchased all necessary furniture, books, equipments, etc as well as hired the staff to run the institute. The location for the college was finalized in the picturesque outskirts of the city. Seth Pertab Rai Manghar Singh and few others donated their best chunk of 64 acres of cultivated land for this noble cause. To pay tribute to Dr. Besant,

the college was inaugurated on 1st October, 1917 on her birthday anniversary. Dr. Wood was appointed its founder Principal. The college was initially funded through National Educational Trust. Later on in 1921, the college with all its assets was handed over to "Diwan Metharam Darmada Trust" (DMD) ran by Diwan Dayaram Gidumal who donated an amount of Rs.100000/= for the affiliation of the college with Bombay University. On the death of Diwan Dayaram Gidumal, the college was renamed after him as D.G. National College Hyderabad.

The college initially began its journey as intermediate Arts College, soon the courses offered were B.Sc. in Industrial Science; B.A. in Agriculture and Political Science; and B.Com. In June 1927, B.A. (Hons.) in English, History, Economics and Philosophy were also offered. In 1934, Intermediate science classes were also started which made the college a Science College as well. In 1940, there was commencement of M.A. classes in Sindhi Literature. In 1945, classes for B.Sc. were started in Zoology, Botany and Chemistry. Later on due to political turmoil in the Indian sub-continent, the college was closed and its faculty and other staff migrated from

Hyderabad to other parts of India leaving behind the deserted institute.

The second phase of this historic educational institution began after the establishment of Pakistan. Due decided to migrate to Bombay. The deserted D.G. National College Hyderabad due to this voluntary exodus of its original owners was taken over by Government of Sindh and it decided to reopen it on 21st June, 1948 with the title "D. G. National Government College Hyderabad". Prof. Dr. Adrian Duarte was

Appointed as its Principal. Dr. Duarte had to re-establish the college from scratches. The re-birth of this marvelous institute took place under the remarkable leadership of appointed as its Principal. Dr. Duarte had to re-establish the college from scratches. The re-birth of this marvelous institute took place under the remarkable leadership of Dr. Duarte with 224 students on the roll and a faculty comprised of 6 professors, 15 Lecturers and 3 demonstrators. There was co-education till 1952-52 as there was no college for the girls. On 9th April, 1949, the college was renamed as "Government Arts College, Hyderabad". Later, on 7th March, 1951, the college was renamed as "Government College Hyderabad" through a





government resolution and was allowed to teach upto B.Sc. stage in affiliation with Sind University. Within next few years, there was a great increase the number of science students. During the academic session 1952-53, the enrolment surpassed 1000.

Government College Hyderabad has the honour of first starting post-graduate classes in Arts and Science of Sind University after its migration from Karachi to Hyderabad and its professors were given the status of part-time Professors of the University. With the commencement of M.A. (Urdu; & English) and M.Sc. (Physics; Chemistry; Mathematics; and Statistics) in 1991 and later M.Sc. in Zoology and Botany in 1993 ushered in a new era in the history of this institution. Another milestone in the pathway towards the success was commencement of Bachelor of Computer Science (BCS) in 2002.

During 1988, the foundation of its Alumni Association by the old boys proved to be another milestone towards the up-gradation from college to university. The demand towards the up-gradation as university however, touched its peak when one of its shining stars, Raja Pervez Ashraf occupied the highest seat of Prime

Minister of Islamic Republic of Pakistan. His excellency, Raja Pervez Ashraf visited his alma mater on 23rd February, 2013. Although, he was motivated enough to announce the upgradation as University, unfortunately due to some political constrains the demand remained in vain. However, the Alumni did not give up. The centennial celebration was approaching very soon in 2017. The top focus of the Alumni was up-gradation of their alma mater as University. The Alumni was determined to keep calling attention of the political, social and educational leadership towards the noble cause of the establishment of Government College University Hyderabad. In this regard, on 24th January, 2016, the visit to Sindh Assembly, Karachi to meet Mr. Nisar Ahmed Khuhro, then Senior Minister and Minister of Education, Sindh proved to be very important in calling attention of the government officials towards the preservation of the historic architect of college buildings and the up-gradation as well. The alumni delegate comprised of Principal, Prof. Dr. Nasiruddin Shaikh, Mr. Abdul Rehman Rajput (President Alumni), Prof. Nazir Ahmed Qasmi (Ex GS Alumni) and Prof. M. Saleem Mughal (GS, Alumni). As a consequence of this Meeting, honourable EM, Mr. Khuhro appreciated the concerns of Alumni regarding up-gradation as well as preservation of the historic building. He sanctioned a





Huge grant for rehabilitation, renovation and restoration of college buildings. He also approved one week long celebration program. Later on 12th April, 2016, a resolution regarding the up gradation of Government College Hyderabad was passed unanimously in Sindh Assembly. It was put forward by Engineer Sabir Kaim Khani, MPA of MPP. On 18th August, 2017, once another delegate of Alumni comprised of Prof. Dr. Nasiruddin Shaikh, Prof. Muhammad Idris Khan, Mr. Abdul rehman Raput (Ex MPA), Mr. Mazhar ul Haq Siddiqui (Ex VC, Sindh University), Mr. Kazi Asad Abid (renowned Journalist), met with Excellency Syed Murad Ali Shah, Chief Minister, Sindh. The meeting was attended by Honourable Dr. Jam Mehtab Dahr, Minister of Education Sindh, Mr. Suhail Ahmed Rajput, (Special Secretary to CM Sindh), Secretary Universities and Boards, Mr. Naveed Shaikh, Secretary, Colleges Education, Mr. Pervez Ahmed Sehar and phulelian Ashfaq Ahmed Laghari. The delegate briefed the Excellency CM about the great contribution of their alma mater in nation building and services being rendered for almost a century. The delegate reiterated the Alumni demand for the up gradation of Govt. College Hyd as a university. The CM Sindh

appreciated the concerns of all Phulelians. He primarily agreed to grant the status of the university and promised to announce himself in centennial celebration of Government College Hyderabad. Finally, the dreamed day arrived. On 9th October, 2017, presiding over the seminar "Government College Hyderabad: Past, Present and Future", in connection to centenary celebration held at the Assembly Hall of Government College Hyd, His Excellency, Syed Murad Ali Shah, CM Sindh officially announced the up gradation of the status of Government College Hyderabad as University. The Sindh Government Gazette notification vide, title "Government College University Hyderabad Act 2018" was issued on 21st May, 2018 by Provincial Assembly of Sindh thus conferring upon official status to Government College University Hyderabad. On 16th March 2018, 100 acres of land (Form VIII Jaryan 522, Dated: 23rd Jan, 2018) was allotted to establish a campus at Ganjo Takar, Deh Gujo, Hyd-Badin Road, Hyderabad. The official letter issued on 16th May, 2018 by Secretary to Govt. of Sindh, Land Utilization Department. The official notification of appointment of Prof. Dr. Nasiruddin Shaikh (Principal, GCHYD) as Acting Vice Chancellor on 13th February, 2019 created a boom and boost to the tedious basic ground work of GC University Hyderabad; the statutory

The official visit of HEC Inspection team was being arranged on 15th May, 2019. The Inspection team comprised of Prof. Dr. Muhammad Arshad Zia, International Islamic University, Islamabad, Prof. Dr. Zareen Abbasi, University of Sindh, Jamshoro, Deputy Director and Assistant Director, HEC, Islamabad. After evaluation of physical, financial and academic infrastructure, the official NOC of HEC, Islamabad was issued very soon by DG (Accreditation & Attestation) vide letter no. 17(55)/A&A/Acc/HEC-2019/2630, dated June 17, 2019 being granted for BS (undergraduate programs) in Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science, Zoology, Botany, Mathematics, English and Education departments.

# ABOUT UNIVERSITY

The Government College Hyderabad was established in 1917. Before the partition of the sub-continent, a board of trustees was administering this institution. However, all of them migrated to India in 1947. The Government of Sindh took over the college on 21st June 1948. The college imparted education up to intermediate level to the students of the faculty of science and up to B.A (Hons) to the students belonging to the Faculty of Arts.

Total number of the students enrolled in 1948-49 was 224 and total number of teachers was 25. There was co-education in this institute up to 1951-52 as there was no separate college for the girls by then.

The faculty of science was upgraded to the degree classes in March 1951 as the number of students wishing to seek admission in B.Sc. class soared rapidly. In 1961-62 the University of Sindh took over teaching of honours classes. Ever since 1948, the college continues to occupy unique positions as a premier institution of the province of Sindh, the students of this college have been achieving enviable position in various examination conducted by the board of intermediate & secondary education, Hyderabad and the University of Sindh. A glimpse of the honours list placed in the assembly hall bears testimony to this claim likewise, our students continue to win a large number of prizes and trophies in the field of extra-curricular activities. A large number of old boys of this college are now serving the nation in senior administrative position and other field of nation building activities.

NO.FASLEGIS-B-08/2018-The Provincial Assembly of Sindh in its sitting held on 02<sup>nd</sup> March, 2018 passed the Government College University Hyderabad Bill, 2018 and was sent to Honourable Governor for accord his assent as required under clause (2)(a) of Article 116 but he, instead of accord assent to the Bill, returned the same with message in exercise of powers vested upon him under clause 2(b) of Article 116.

The Provincial Assembly of Sindh in its sitting held on 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 reconsidered the Bill and passed it again which was accordingly sent to the Governor for accord his assent. The period of ten days has been elapsed and the subject bill shall be deemed to have been assented by the Governor in view of clause (3) of Article 116 of the Constitution and is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sindh.

## GENERAL REGULATIONS GOVERNING ADMISSION

- i) All admissions shall be provisional until approved by the Vice Chancellor
- ii) The Vice Chancellor may refuse admission to the University classes to any candidate without assigning any reason.
- iii) The foreign national candidates must be nominated/ recommended by the Ministry of Education/Ministry of Finance & Economic Affairs Division, Government of Pakistan, Islamabad and HEC.
- iv) A candidate who has not passed an examination from BISE Hyderabad shall have to obtain Certificate of Eligibility from the Government College University Hyderabad prior to his/her admission to any class. However, the Registrar may issue a provisional admission certificate if he is satisfied that the applicant is *prima facie* eligible for admission to this University. At his/her **OWN RISK AND COST** and on the condition that he/she obtains a final certificate of eligibility within 30 days from the date of admission.
- v) 05 marks will be deducted for every calendar year of the candidates who have passed HSC before 1997.
- vi) 20 marks will be awarded to the candidates who have completed Hifz-e-Quran, provided that they produce sanad/certificate from registered madresha and other necessary requirements.
- vii) The candidates who have passed HSC Part-II from B.I.S.E. Hyderabad/Karachi/Mirpurkhas/Larkana/Sukkur must have domicile of Sindh.

- v) Candidates who have passed Annual examination HSC Part-II (Pre-Medical/Pre-Engineering/General Science/Humanities) or equivalent examination/certificate O-Level & A-Level 2019 upto Annual Examination 2017 with at least 50% aggregate marks are eligible to apply for admission under Regular or Self Supporting scheme.
- vi) The admission shall be purely on merit basis and subject to the availability of seats in the subject/course of study
- vii) Every selected candidate must inform in writing his/her choice of two minors/supporting subjects to the Chairperson of the department in which admitted within ONE WEEK from the commencement of teaching. No change of minor subjects will be allowed thereafter.
- viii) Candidates who have passed HSC in Pre-Medical Group can apply for 4-years BS Program in Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, English and B.Ed (Hons.).
- ix) Candidates who have passed HSC in Pre-Engineering Group are eligible to apply for 4-years BS Program in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, English as well as 4-Years B.Ed. (Hons).
- x) Candidates who have passed HSC in General Science Group are eligible to apply for 4-Years BS Program in Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics, English as well as 4-Years B.Ed. (Hons).
- xi) Candidates who have passed HSC in Humanities Group are eligible to apply for 4-Years BS Program in English as well as 4-Years B.Ed. (Hons).
- xii) For 4-Years B.Ed. (Hons) Program, candidates who have HSC in Pre-Med; Pre-Eng; General Science; Humanities; Commerce or equivalent group can apply.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND OTHER RULES

- i) Candidate who has passed the H.S.C., (Intermediate) Pre-Medical; Pre-Engineering; General Science; Commerce; Humanities groups or an equivalent examination recognized by the University.
- ii) Minimum percentage of marks in H.S.C., or equivalent is not less than 50% of marks obtained.
- iii) Candidate must have scored at least 40% marks in Pre-Entry Test of GCUH.
- iv) Any other condition prescribed for any subject specified by GCUH.

## FILING-IN OF THE LEFT OVER SEATS:

- i) The GCUH authority reserves the right to fill in the left over seats in any category from waiting list of candidates of BISE Hyderabad on merit basis.
- ii) As regards (i) above, the left over seats because of non-payment of fees, if any within the prescribed time limit, the seat shall be considered as left over and filled in as per procedure prescribed therein and selected candidates whose seats have fallen vacant due to non-payment of fee, if any, for whatever reason, shall not claim the admission and shall not challenge the admission of any other candidate selected in his/her place in particular or any other quota oriented course or general course of study mentioned by him/her in the Admission form.



## PRE ENTRY TEST

- Entry Test is mandatory for admissions in any discipline/program of GCUH whether as regular candidate, or reserved seats or on self-support basis.
- To qualify for admission, the minimum acceptable score for GCUH is 40% in Pre Entry Test.
- The Pre Entry Test will be based upon MCQs.
- The Pre Entry Test shall be based on subjects studied at HSC level.
- There will be no negative marking in Pre-Entry Test.
- Time allowed for Pre Entry Test is 2 Hours.
- For candidates seeking admission in 4-years BS Program as well as B.Ed (Hons) Program, the Entry Test shall cover the different areas as follows:

### Pre-Medical Group:

Physics + Chemistry + Biology + English = Total 100 Questions (25 questions from each concentration).

### Pre-Engineering Group:

Physics + Chemistry + Mathematics + English = Total 100 Questions (25 questions from each concentration).

### General Science Group:

Physics + Computer Science + Mathematics + English = Total 100 Questions (25 questions from each concentration).

### Arts Group:

Pakistan Studies + Islamiyat + General Mathematics + English = Total 100 Questions (25 questions from each concentration).

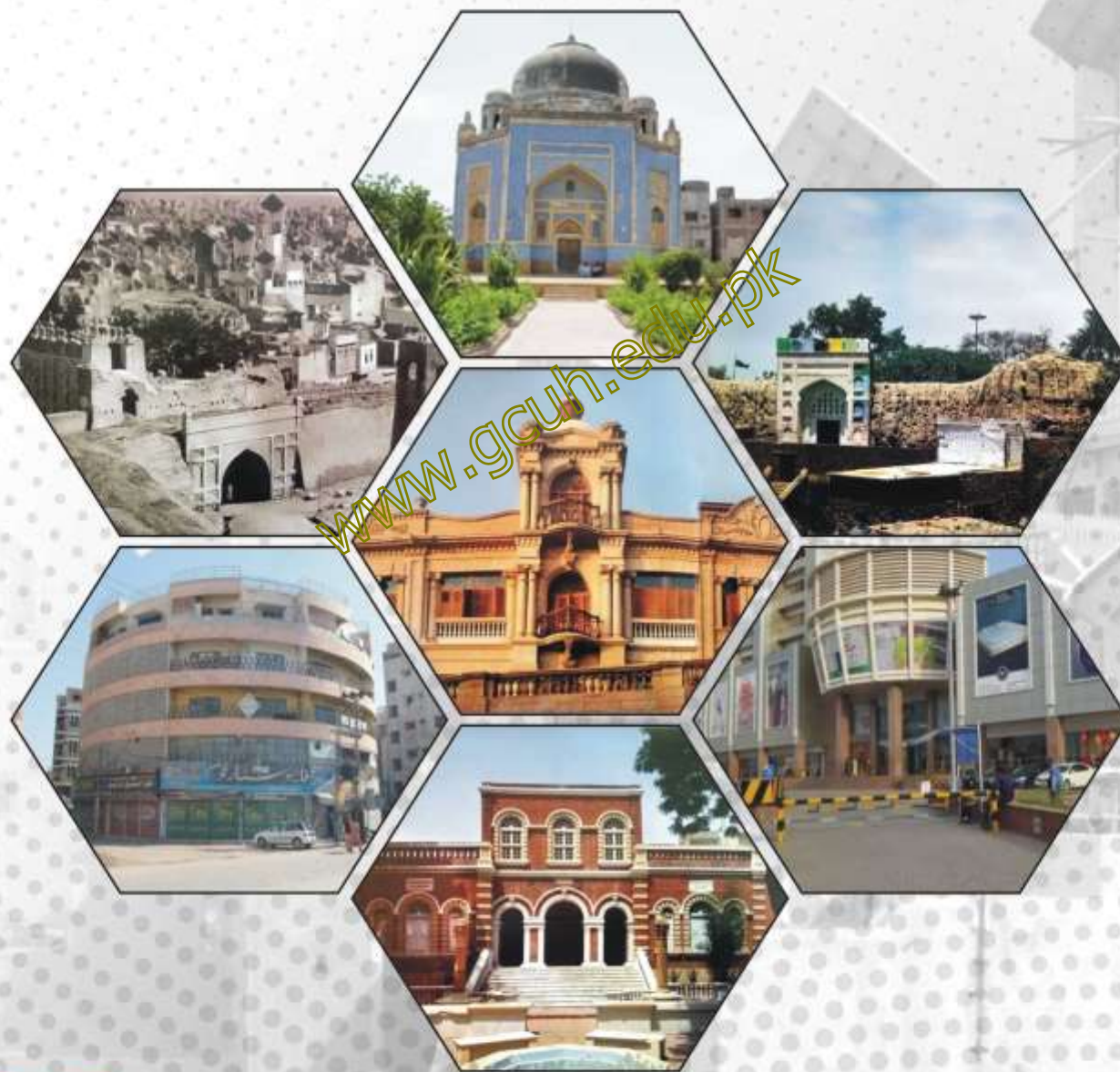


## HYDERABAD AT A GLANCE

Famous of its wind-catchers and the cool breezed nights, Hyderabad as far as the demographic data concerned, is the second largest cities of the province of Sindh. Rich in its traditions and culture, its origin dates back to medieval times. It has been the Capital city of Sind under many dynasties that ruled Sindh. The main city originally located towards the left bank of River Indus, on a narrow strip of hill, the Ganjo Takkar has now spread around administratively into a district with an area of about 104877 hectares and a population of 2,199,000 (2017 Census). It has now been divided into four administrative talukas, viz., Hyderabad rural, Hyderabad city, Latifabad and Qasimabad. Ghulam Shah Kalhoro (1757-1772), the famous ruler of Sindh has been regarded as the "founder of Hyderabad". Later (1783-1843), during the reign of Talpur, the city of Hyderabad flourished. A symbol of great blessing, Iranian rulers gifted the "Foot prints of Hazrat Ali (Karam-ul-Ilah wajho)" which was mounted to a place close to Pucca Qilla, now famous as "qadam gah e Mola Ali". It's a place of pilgrimage for all muslims. Once being dominated by Hindus, Hyderabad gradually became the Muslim majority with the partition of Indian sub-continent into India and Pakistan. As a consequence of mass migration of Muslims from India in newly established Pakistan and especially their settlement in Sindh and vice versa sindhi hindus to India, Sindh turned into Muslim majority area. The muslim migrants from India were mostly skilled workers, artists, poets, writers, businessmen and literate people. It played a pivotal role in the developing the diversity of culture and traditions.

# MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (M.I.S.)

Keeping in view of the use of modern trends and technology in education, Management Information System (M.I.S.) was established at Government College Hyderabad in 2017. The Government College Hyderabad is the Pioneer in establishing computerized attendance of the students through Bar-coded Identity Cards. The mission was to preserve all the data of students, faculty, other staff, budgeting, etc. through developing a database. Moreover, a campus surveillance system through C.C. TV had also to be installed and to be connected through this network. Though there were many constraints, we started bit by bit. Initially a centralized control room was established to install server, PCs, networking, etc. An internet WiFi connectivity was also developed. Through the data, we generated computerized bar-coded and photo-printed Identity PVC cards especially for recording daily attendance of all the students with check-in and check-out timings. This was also helpful in keeping their academic progress in monthly, mid-term and final-term examinations and reporting it directly to their parents through SMS. Likewise, faculty and other staff data was also being collected to help generating their Identity cards and its interpretation as required from time to time by the authorities. ## General Instructions

**Note:** University of Sindh will not apply negative marking in multiple choice questions test paper for admission to Bachelors degree programs from the academic year 2019. You must have to secure minimum passing marks (40%) to pass the test. Otherwise you will not be eligible for admission.

**Important:** You are not allowed to use any device during test hours, which could assist you in calculating e.g calculator tables or mobile phones etc.

## Personal Information on Answer Sheet

The answer sheet contains personal data of candidate on the top of the sheet. It has candidates', name, father name, roll number and photograph. The candidate is required to critically check these fields and sign in the required space. If any field of personal information is found incorrect the candidate must inform the invigilator present around.

- Reporting time at test centre as specified on roll number slip.
- No candidate will be admitted in the test centre after specified time.
- Candidates will have to produce their roll number slips at the entry point of the test centre.
- Without the roll number slip no candidate will be entertained for the test.

## Composition of Test

- Question booklets will be in five different shuffles.
- Each question booklet will be sealed and opened by the candidates at the start of test.
- Do not break the seal till the test starts.
- No candidate will be allowed to leave the seat during the test except for an un-avoidable reason e.g. toilet usage, that to in the escort of an invigilator.

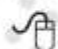
