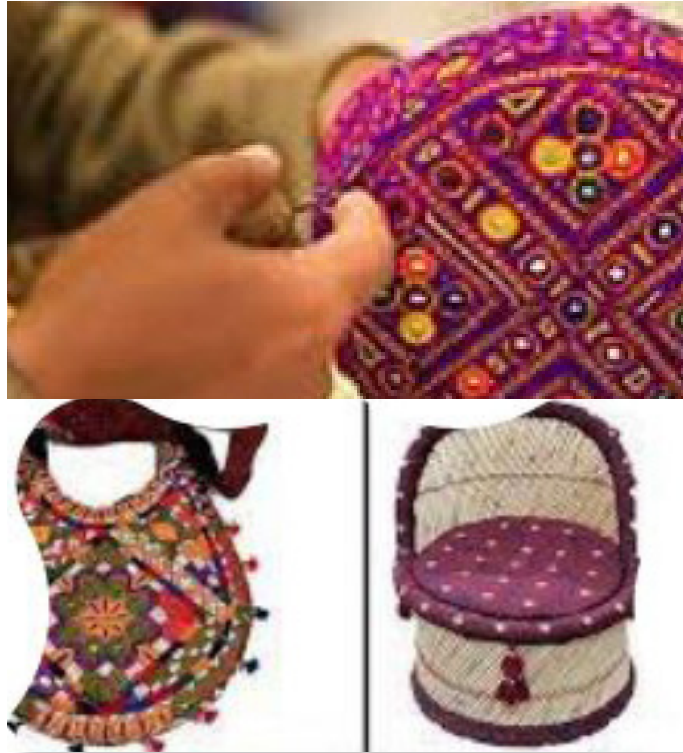
A Glimpse into the Exhibition by Creative Society

Multicultural Day Celebrations at GCUH

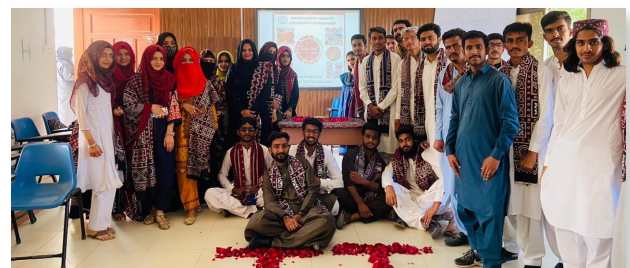
Date: 2nd December 2022
