HISTORY & BACKGROUND

Government College University Hyderabad is one of Pakistan's oldest and prime educational institutions. Its genesis dates back to 1 October 1917, with the title of "Sindh National Arts College Hyderabad" have been contemplated by the International Theosophical Society. The crucial role in running the International Theosophical Society was played by its second president, Dr. Annie Besant, a well-known educationist, orator, political and social figure of the undivided Indian sub-continent. Another famous figure Dr. Ernest Egerton Wood, the secretary to the National Educational Trust, continued "National Educational Movement" activities. He appealed through the newspapers for the establishment of new educational institutes in India. Since there was no college in Hyderabad Sindh, the students who wanted to continue higher education had to go to far-off cities like Bombay. The first response of enormous contribution appeared from a youth of Sindh with a donation of Rs. 20,000/= on a condition to establish a college in Hyderabad, Sindh. Another important figure among the city's aristocracy was Diwan Dayaram Gidumal, a judge by profession. He was the driving factor behind the establishment of college in Hyderabad. Dr. Wood landed in Hyderabad, Sindh, on August 24, 1917, after a long journey from Madras. The people of Hyderabad Sindh gave a large sum of money, estimated to be over Rs. 5000/= in less than a week. The donation was quite enough to launch the institute. Dr. Wood, within five weeks, purchased all necessary furniture, books, equipment, etc. and hired the staff to run the institute. The college's location was decided on amid the city's scenic surroundings. Seth Pertab Rai Manghar Singh and a few others contributed their best piece of 64 acres of cultivated land for this beautiful deed. The date of the college's foundation was chosen to coincide with Dr. Besant's birthday, 1 October 1917. Dr. Wood was appointed its founder Principal. The National Educational Trust provided the initial funding for the college. Later, in 1921, the college was given to the "Diwan Metharam Darmada Trust" (DMD), which was run by Diwan Dayaram Gidumal, who provided Rs. 100,000/= for the college's affiliation with Bombay University. After Diwan Dayaram Gidumal's death, the college was renamed D.G. National College Hyderabad. The college initially began its journey as an intermediate Arts College, soon the courses were offered B.Sc. in Industrial Science, B.A. in Agriculture and Political Science, and B.Com. In June 1927, B.A. (Hons.) in English, History, Economics, and Philosophy were also offered. In 1934, Intermediate science classes were also started, which made the college a Science College. In 1940, there was the commencement of M.A. classes in Sindhi Literature. In 1945, classes for B.Sc. were started in Zoology, Botany, and Chemistry. Later on, due to political turmoil in the Indian sub-continent, the college was closed. Its faculty and other staff migrated from Hyderabad to other parts of India, leaving behind the institute deserted. The second phase of this historic educational institution began after the establishment of Pakistan. The deserted D.G. National College Hyderabad, due to the voluntary departure of its original owners, was taken over by the Government of Sindh. It was decided to re-open it on 21 June 1948 with the same name, "D.G. National Government College Hyderabad". Prof. Dr. Adrian Duarte was appointed as its Principal. Dr. Duarte had to rebuild the college again from the ground level. The extraordinary leadership of the appointed Principal was instrumental in the re-birth of this fantastic institute. The re-birth of this glorious institute took place under remarkable leadership with 224 students on the roll and a faculty comprised of 6 professors, 15 Lecturers, and three demonstrators. There was co-education till 1952-. as there was no college for the girls. The Institution remained co-educational until 1952/95 there was no Separate College for Girls. On 9th April 1949, the college was renamed "Government Arts College, Hyderabad". Later, on 7th March 1951, the college was renamed "Government College Hyderabad" through a government resolution and was allowed to teach up to B.Sc. level in affiliation with Sindh University. Within the next few years, there was a significant increase in the number of science students. During the academic session 1952-53, the enrolment surpassed 1000. Government College Hyderabad has the honor of starting post-graduate classes in Arts and Science for the first time after Sindh University was shifted from Karachi to Hyderabad. Its professors were given the status of part-time Professors of the University. The commencement of M.A. and M.Sc. in 1991 & 1993 ushered a new era in the history of this institution. Another milestone in the pathway towards success was the commencement of Bachelor of Computer Science (BCS) in 2002. Being one of the old institutions of Sindh and with heritage in academic excellence, people of Hyderabad, Alumni and the faculty of this institution looked forward for the up-gradation to the level of university. The demand towards the up-gradation as University touched its peak when one of its shining stars, Raja Pervez Ashraf, occupied the highest seat of Prime Minister of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

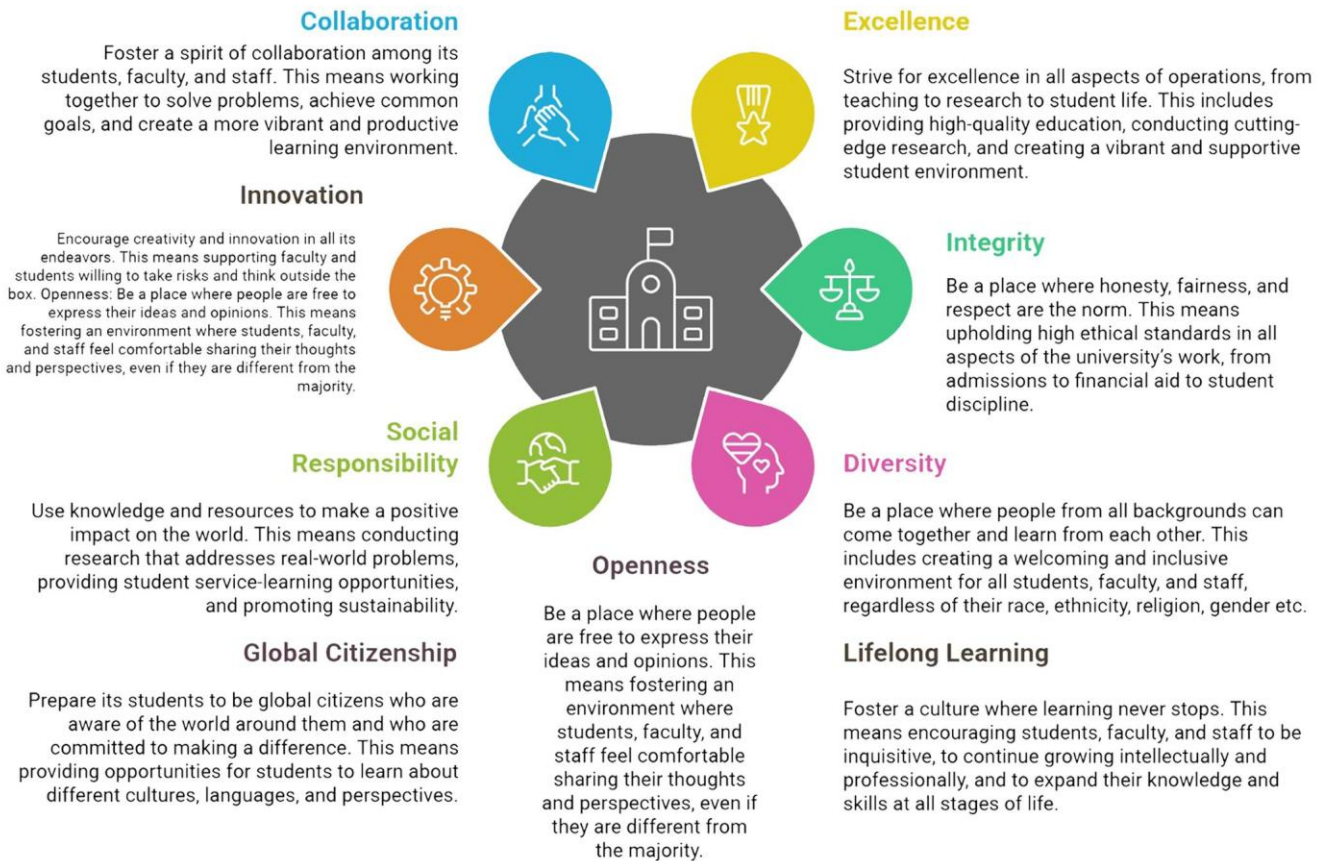
His Excellency, Raja Pervez Ashraf, visited his alma mater on 23rd February 2013. The Alumni and the faculty members of Government College Hyderabad were determined to keep calling the attention of the political, social and educational leadership towards the noble cause of the establishment of Government College University Hyderabad. A delegate of Alumni met with Excellency Syed Murad Ali Shah, Chief Minister, Sindh. The delegate briefed the Excellency CM about the outstanding contribution of their alma mater in nation-building and services being rendered for almost a century. The representative reiterated the Alumni demand for the up-gradation of Government College Hyderabad to a university. The CM Sindh appreciated the concerns of all Phulelians. The long-awaited day finally arrived. His excellency, Syed Murad Ali Shah, CM Sindh, officially announced the up-gradation of the status of Government College Hyderabad as University on 9th of October 2017, while presiding over the seminar "Government College Hyderabad: Past, Present, and Future" at the Assembly Hall of Government College Hyderabad. The Sindh Government Gazette notification vide, the title "Government College University Hyderabad Act 2018", was issued on 21st May 2018 by the Provincial Assembly of Sindh, thus conferring upon official status to Government College University Hyderabad.

LEGAL FRAMEWORK AND BY-LAWS

The legal framework for the establishment and operation of Government College University Hyderabad, Sindh, Pakistan, is provided by the GCUH Act 2018. The Act outlines the governance structure of the university, academic policies, financial management, and other important matters. The Act also establishes the university's statutory bodies, which are responsible for ensuring compliance with legal requirements.

Senate

The Senate has the authority to review and approve draft statutes from the Syndicate, consider and pass resolutions on the annual report, accounts, and budget, and appoint members to the Syndicate and other Authorities. It may also delegate its powers to committees or officers and perform additional functions as prescribed by statutes.

Syndicate

The Syndicate is responsible for the overall governance of Government College University Hyderabad. It approves policies related to administrative matters such as human resources, infrastructure development, and student affairs. The GCUH has a very dynamic and vibrant Syndicate that regularly meets and discusses the progress, policies, and practices of the university and provides guidance as well as approvals on matters of finance, administration, academics, and overall operations.

Academic Council

The Academic Council is responsible for overseeing academic matters at Government College University Hyderabad. It approves new degree programs, reviews existing programs, and ensures that academic standards are maintained. The Academic Council at GCUH has been constituted, notified, and functioning as per the GCUH Act 2018.

The Selection Board

The Selection Board is responsible for overseeing the recruitment and selection process at the GCUH. The Selection Board scrutinizes the profiles of applicants for appointment to various positions of the varsity, reviews cases of promotion, and appoints eminently qualified persons as a recommendatory forum for the University Syndicate. The Selection Board at GCUH has been constituted, notified, and functioning as per the GCUH Act 2018.

Finance and Planning Committee

The Finance and Planning Committee is a statutory body of the University constituted to oversee matters related to financial planning, budgeting, resource allocation, and long-term development. The Committee is responsible for reviewing and recommending financial proposals, development plans, revised budgets, creation of posts, and other matters having financial implications, with the objective of ensuring efficient utilization of resources, financial sustainability, and alignment with the University's academic and strategic priorities.

Board of Studies & Faculties

The Advanced Studies & Research Board is responsible for advising the authorities on all matters connected with advanced studies and research at the university. It is also mandated to consider instituting various research degrees, finalize research supervisors, and form panels for various studies as well as for students undertaking research at the highest level. GCUH has notified the ASRB with the approval of the statutory body of the university.

Ethos and Leadership

Government College University Hyderabad places a strong emphasis on inclusivity and consultative approaches in its leadership practices. The institution recognizes that diversity is a strength and strives to create an environment where everyone feels valued and respected. Teachers, students, and parents are encouraged to participate in decision-making processes with an aim to continuously improve the university. The vision, mission and values of the University resonate in the policies and practices of the university leadership, may it be individuals bestowed with a leadership position or a forum empowered to exercise collective wisdom for leadership role and decision making. The Government College University Hyderabad has a well-defined leadership structure that is designed to ensure that the institution operates in an efficient and effective manner.

The Government College University Hyderabad (GCUH) envisions imparting modern education enriched with social, ethical, and cultural values, producing leaders equipped to drive Pakistan toward prosperity. 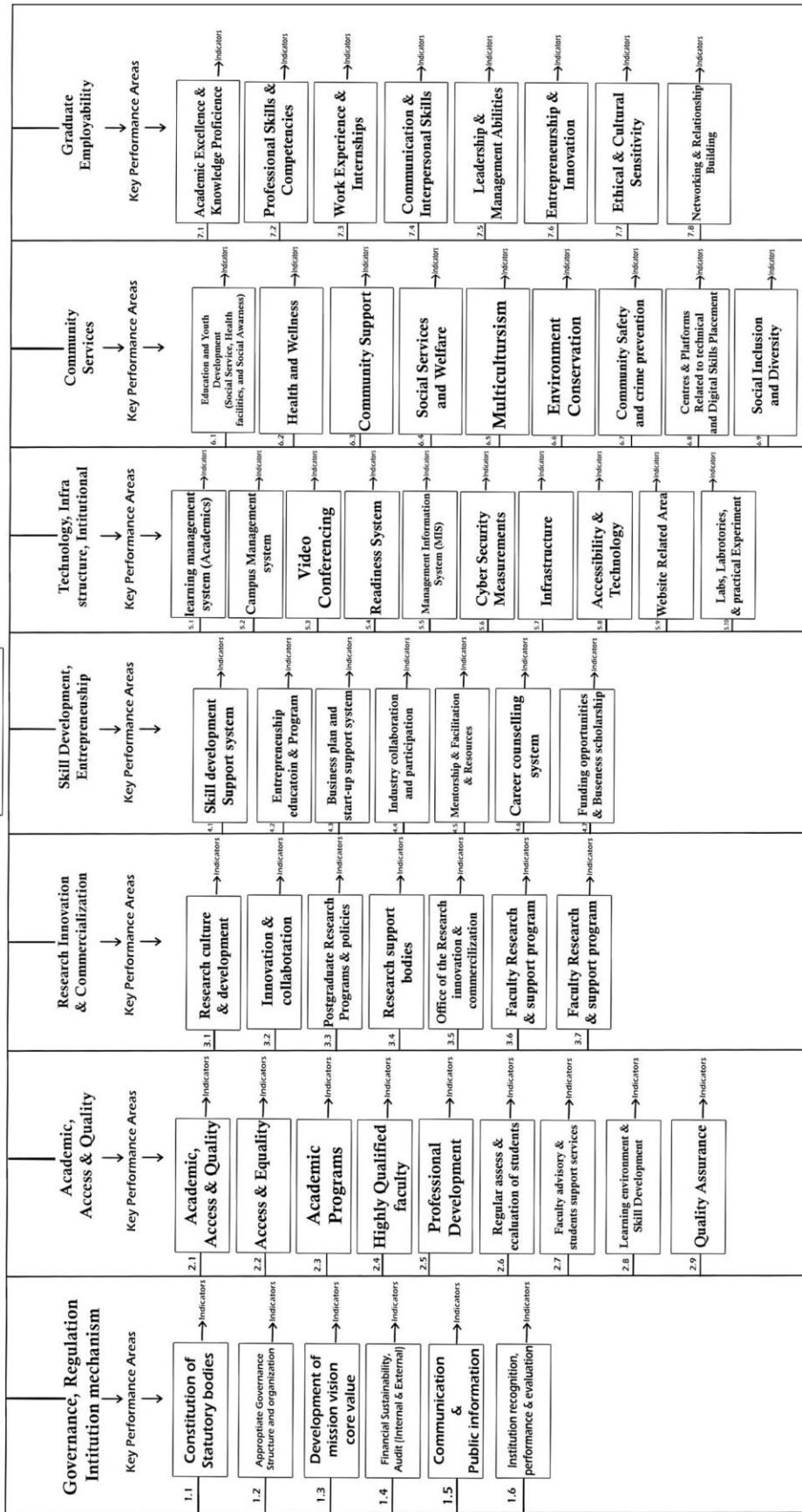
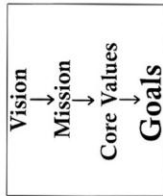
Academic Expansion and Student Opportunities

Prestigious European Post-Doctoral Distinction

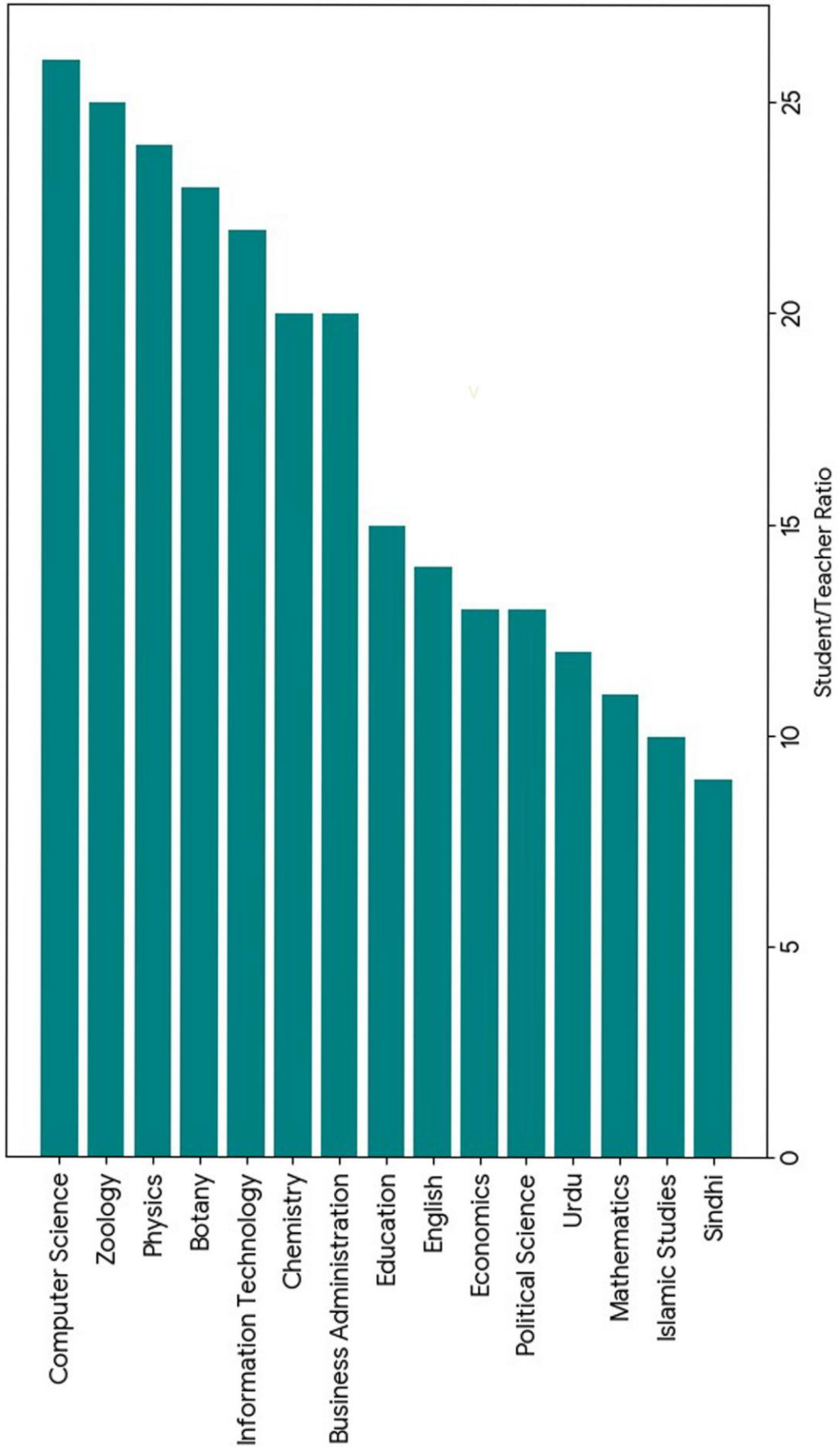

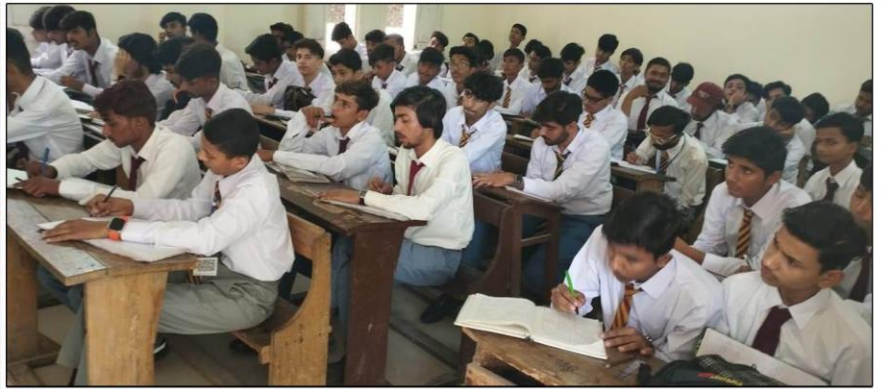

Expanded Online Cataloguing:

We significantly increased our digital footprint by adding new records to the Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC), streamlining the discoverability of our resources for remote users.

Collection Development:

This year, we successfully acquired 367 new books through direct purchase and were honored to receive 425 books as generous donations from various teachers, students' scholars and organizations, further enriching our specialized collections. Information Literacy Workshops:

The library conducted a series of tailored workshops for undergraduate, MPhil, and PhD students. These sessions provided comprehensive training on navigating physical collections and archival materials, maximizing the use of digital resources and e-books, e-journals, and research papers/articles, and mastering the HEC Digital Library (PERN) for advanced online research. These efforts ensure our collections remain inclusive, representative, and vital to the mission of the University.

Key Achievements (2024-2025)

1. Expansion of Digital Infrastructure: Successfully established and inaugurated two additional state-of-the-art E-Libraries to accommodate the growing demand for digital research spaces.
2. HEC Digital Library Integration: Enhanced our partnership with the HEC Digital Library, providing seamless access to e-journals research papers /articles and a vastly expanded catalog of digital text books.
3. Modernization of Facilities: Completed a comprehensive refurbishing project, significantly increasing student seating capacity and introducing ergonomic, collaborative workstations.
4. Governance & Compliance: Implemented updated Library Policies and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) aligned with international 2025 library standards.
5. Collection Maintenance: Conducted campus-wide professional fumigation and deep-cleaning protocols to ensure the longevity of our physical volumes.

In 2025, libraries are evolving from simple book collections into active centers for community and innovation. Strategic plans for the future focus on these main areas:

Technological Innovation & AI.

- Automation: Full automation of services, including remote smart locker solutions for book pickups.
- Digital Collections: Moving toward "hybrid shelves" that display both physical books and digital screens for electronic resources.
- Environmental Programming: Hosting workshops on composting, renewable energy, and sustainable living.
- Library of Things: Lending eco-friendly tools like seed packets, gardening equipment, and home energy monitors.

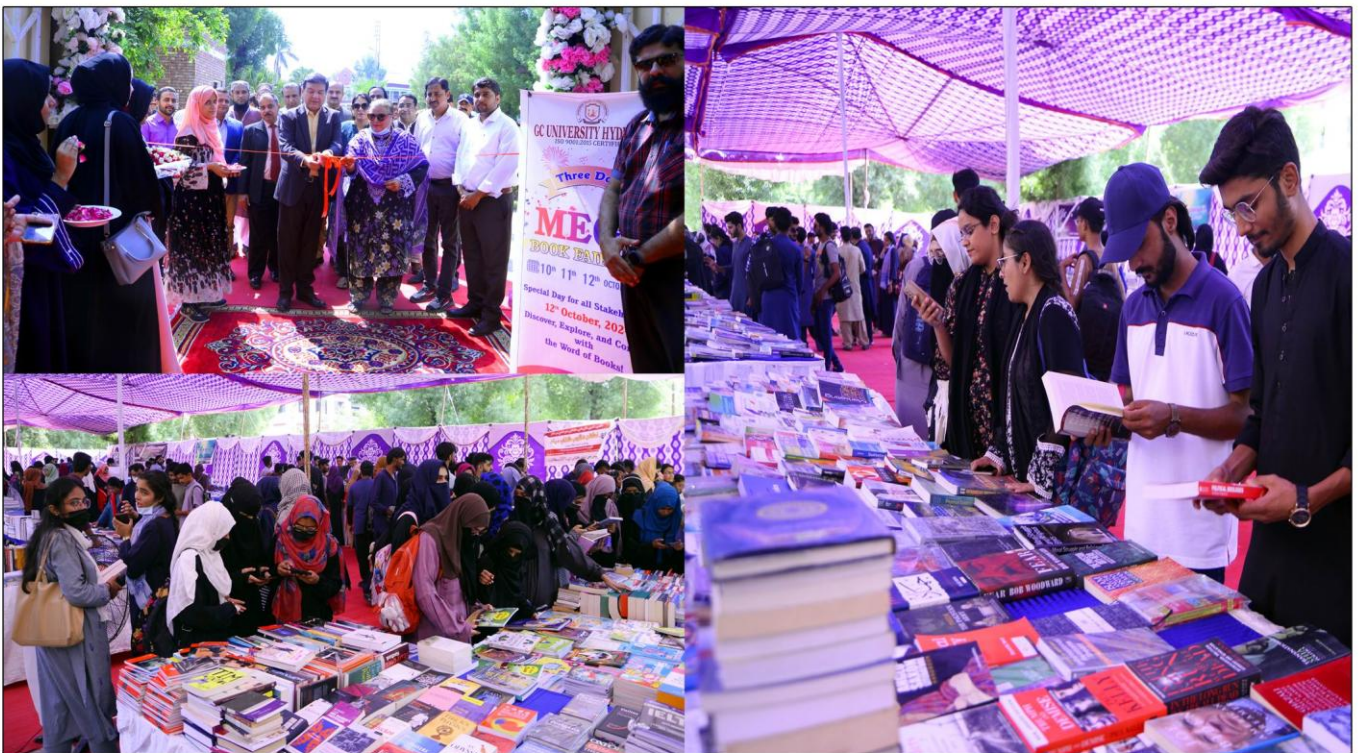

Introduction

The Directorate of Finance of Government College University Hyderabad (GCUH) plays a pivotal role in ensuring sound financial management, fiscal discipline, transparency, and longterm sustainability of the University. During the reporting period, the Directorate continued to strengthen financial governance, audit compliance, and revenue generation mechanisms in line with statutory requirements and the mandate of a Public Sector University.

Financial Overview

During the Financial Year 2024–25, Government College University Hyderabad received a substantial Grant-in-Aid of Rs. 433.00 million from the Sindh Higher Education Commission (SHEC), Government of Sindh, as compared to Rs. 198.00 million received during Financial Year 2023–24. In addition, the University received a recurring grant of Rs. 20.00 million from the Higher Education Commission (HEC), Islamabad. The continued confidence of the Government is further reflected in the enhanced allocation of Rs. 498.00 million for Financial Year 2025–26, which represents a significant increase and demonstrates the commitment of the Government towards strengthening higher education in the province. These enhanced resources enabled the University to support academic programs, meet operational requirements, and plan for infrastructure and student-focused initiatives.

Budget Utilization & Financial Management

The Directorate of Finance ensured effective and timely utilization of allocated funds, primarily towards salaries and operational expenditures, in strict accordance with approved budgets and grant conditions. Emphasis was placed on prudent budgeting, financial controls, and alignment of expenditures with the University's academic and administrative priorities. Strategic financial planning and monitoring mechanisms were implemented to ensure optimal utilization of public funds, compliance with applicable financial rules, and readiness for audit and inspection.

Audit & Compliance

Maintaining transparency and accountability remained a core priority of the University. The audit framework during the reporting period comprised:

- .Internal Audit conducted regularly in compliance with Section 20 of the Government College University Act, 2018.
- .External Audit carried out by the Director General Audit, Sindh, under the Auditor General of Pakistan, covering Financial Years 2019–20 to 2022–23.
- .Third-Party Audit for Financial Year 2024–25, conducted as a mandatory requirement of the Sindh Higher Education Commission.

The third-party audit was conducted by a well-reputed firm of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan, categorized in "A" category by the State Bank of Pakistan. These audits reinforced financial transparency, strengthened internal controls, and provided recommendations for continuous improvement in financial practices.

Revenue Generation Initiatives

In addition to government grants, the University undertook proactive measures to enhance its own revenue generation. Income was generated through admission fees, tuition fees, examination fees, library fees, transport fees, etc. During Financial Year 2024–25, student related fees income increased to Rs. 130.961 million, compared to Rs. 97.206 million in Financial Year 2023–24 due to increase in enrollment. The University also focused on cost optimization initiatives, including the installation of solar energy systems in Academic and Administrative blocks from its own resources to reduce recurring utility expenditures. Being a Public Sector University, GCUH continued to prioritize student support by encouraging scholarships, maintaining affordable fee structures, and facilitating access to higher education for deserving students.

Research & Academic Development Support

The Directorate of Finance supported research and academic development through allocation of funds for conferences, seminars, workshops, symposia, IT infrastructure, research journals, and publications. Research-related expenditures increased from Rs. 34.480 million in FY 2023–24 to Rs. 42.718 million in FY 2024–25, reflecting the University's growing focus on research excellence. Additionally, GCUH strengthened linkages with industry and funding agencies by facilitating internships, industrial scholarships, and research grants from SHEC, HEC Islamabad, and other organizations. The University also received in-kind support in the form of laptops, scanners, furniture, and other equipment to enhance infrastructure and learning facilities.

Investment, Pension & Endowment Funds

In compliance with the directives of the Sindh Higher Education Commission and Higher Education Commission Islamabad, the University ensured timely allocation of Pension Contributions and 10% allocation of SHEC Grants towards the Endowment Fund. Separate bank accounts were maintained for Pension and Endowment Funds. Pension Contribution funds were invested in Term Deposit Receipts (TDRs) to ensure long-term financial sustainability, while Endowment Funds were also invested annually in TDRs to generate resources for research development and academic advancement.

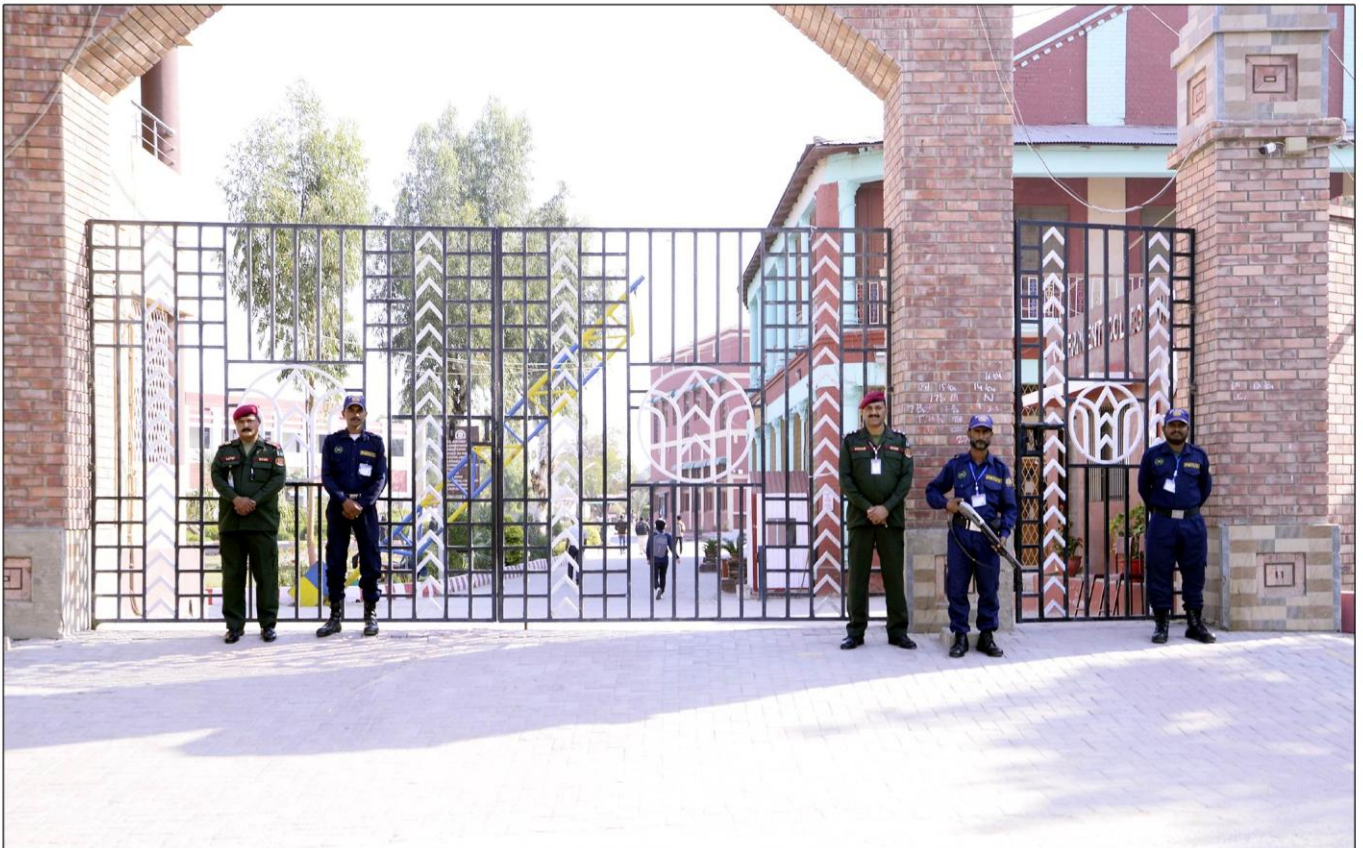

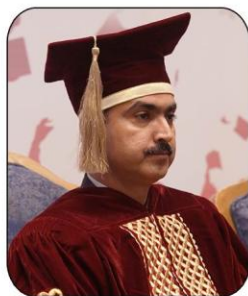


Security and Surveillance

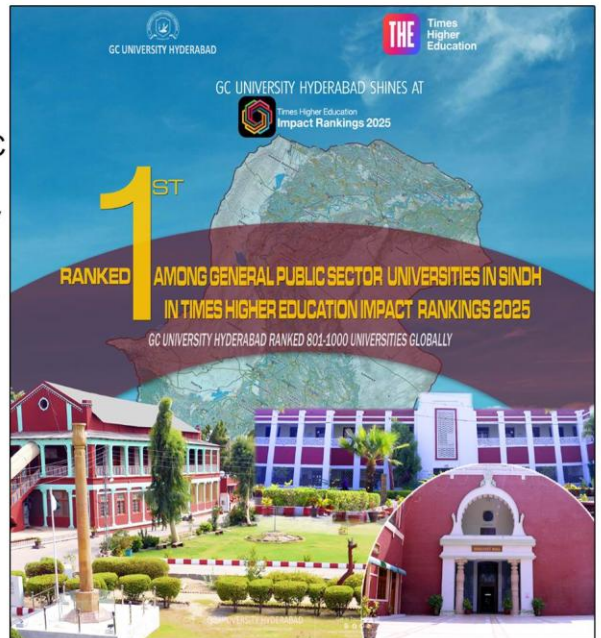

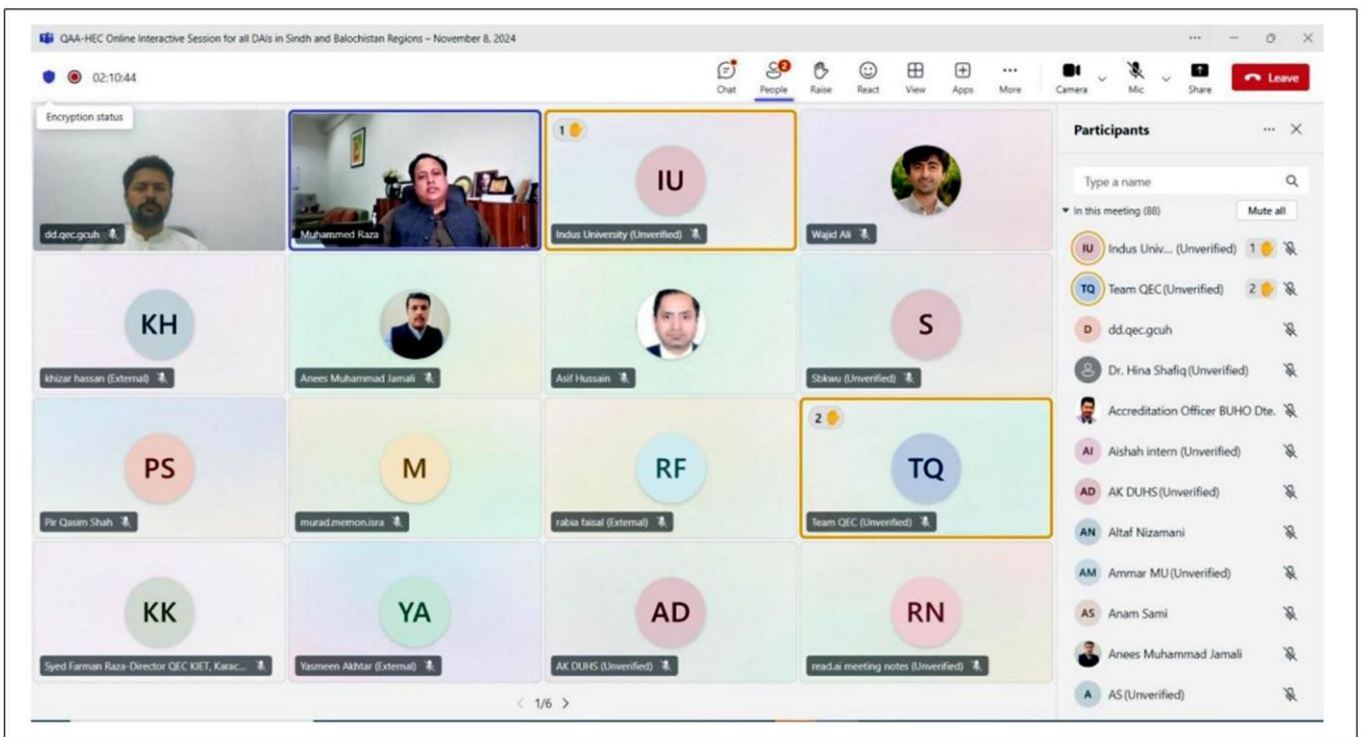
Self-PGPR (M.Phil & PhD Programs)

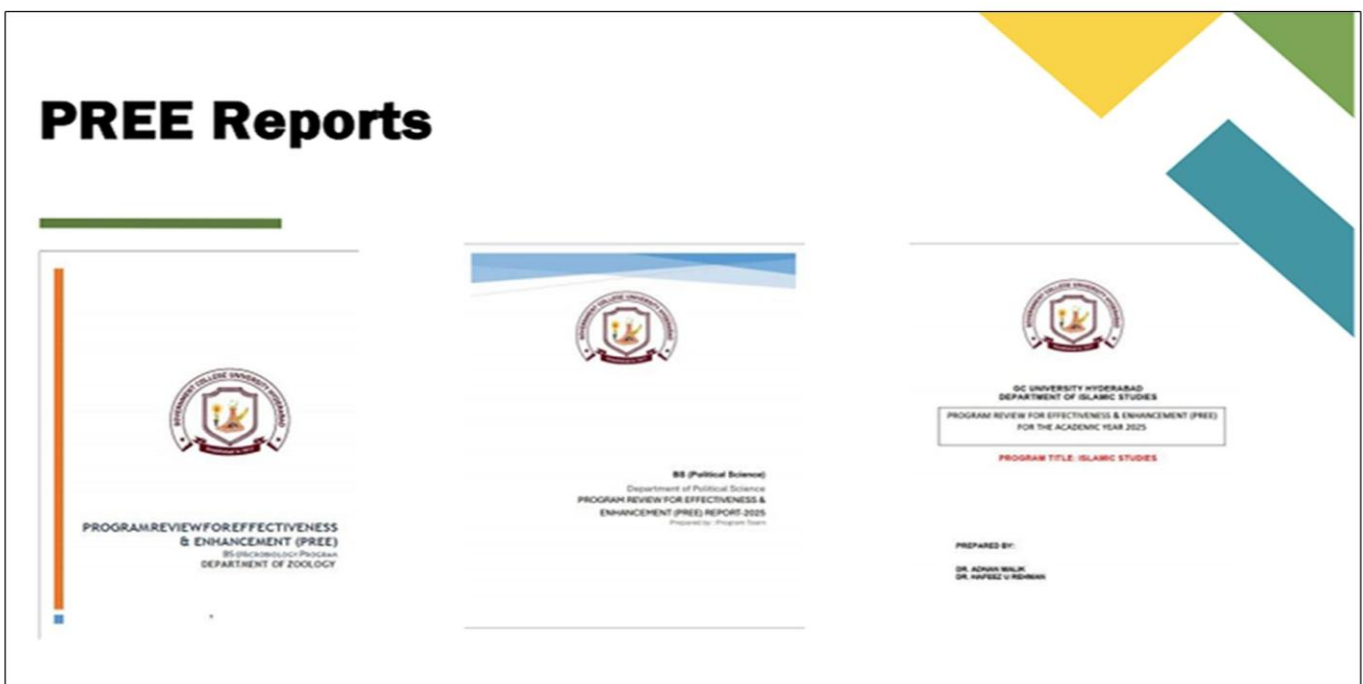
One-Day Workshop on PREE

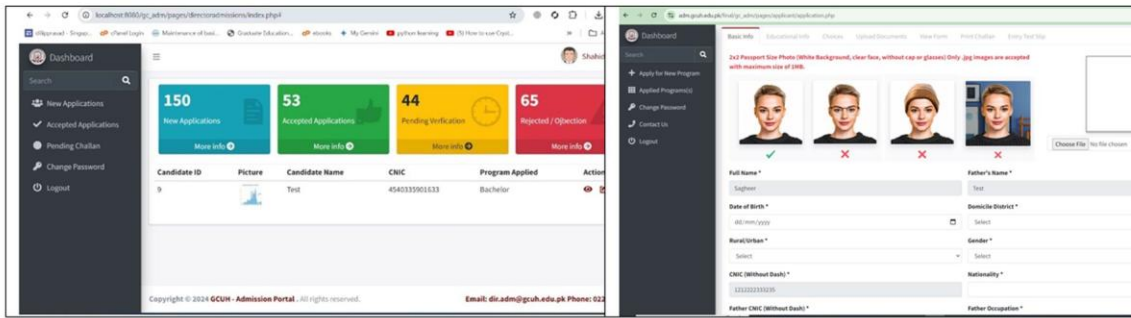


ICPC Annual Achievements
